The credit crisis and its employment consequences

Jouke van Dijk (1956) is Professor of Regional Labour Market Analysis and chair of the Department of Economic Geography at the Faculty of Spatial Sciences of the University of Groningen. He also works parttime for the NICIS Institute, the premier knowledge institute for urban issues, with a focus on reinforcing the economic and social strength of cities and is Board Member of the Wadden Academy, a research institute of the Royal Netherlands Acadmey of Arts and Sciences, that sets the agenda and coordinates research activities in the field of Ecology, Geology, Economics and Social Sciences in the Wadden area. Van Dijk graduated in 1981 in Regional Science at the Faculty of Economics of the University of Groningen. In 1986 he obtained his doctoral degree on the thesis 'Migration and the Labour Market'. From 1981 till 1991 he hold several positions at the Department of Spatial Economics of the Faculty of Economics.

Opinions of Professor Jouke van Dijk

- Building the Zuiderzee Line will not solve the credit crisis' 'The intentions are good, but it's not thought through', is how Jouke van Dijk typifies the proposal by VVD MP Hans van Baalen to return the idea of a Zuiderzee Line to the political agenda as a way of solving the credit crisis. Van Baalen made his proposal during a New Year's gathering organized by Stichting Bedrijfsbelangen Eemshaven. He wants to use the financial crisis to make the Netherlands stronger. Building the Zuiderzee Line would help this, according to Van Baalen. For more information click here.
